The ETHP Leadership Council is a diverse and dynamic set of leaders with a shared vision to build a healthier and more equitable East Toronto, enabling every person and neighbourhood to thrive. Together with our health and social care partners, we are achieving better integration of primary care, health services and social support as we improve health outcomes and reduce health inequities for the people of East Toronto. The Council plays a critical role in overseeing the OHT's strategic direction and governance, ensuring that it remains fiscally responsible, prioritizes community engagement enabling the OHT to adapt to the evolving landscape of the healthcare system.

We are seeking engaged and thoughtful leaders to help us provide collaborative governance and strategic guidance to create healthy neighbourhoods where residents will be connected to a system of care that improves the health and well-being of our communities.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a Senior Leader of a partner organization in the ETHP who can make decisions and commitments on behalf of their organization
- Attend monthly in-person and/or virtual meetings throughout the year

Preference will be given to partners who have demonstrated collaboration and leadership in advancing integrated care in East Toronto.

Responsibilities include (and are not limited to):

- Allocating and leveraging partner organization's resources to plan, design, implement and oversee an integrated care delivery system in East Toronto
- Commitment to transparency and communication with the ETHP Leadership Council and ETHP partners and sharing data in relation to performance, service delivery, quality, and financial data
- Contributing to establishing an overall strategic plan for the ETHP, developing an annual work plan and sharing it with partners
- Reviewing and collaborating on quality and financial performance, resource allocation and use, best practice, innovation and quality improvement, risk allocation and mitigation and corrective actions in respect of ETHP activities
- Being part of one or more subcommittees or program or service task forces to assist ETHP in fulfilling its role
